

The Site Pharmacy Manager is responsible for the functioning of the NOR-MAN Regional Health Authority Pharmacy department in the designated site. Responsibilities relate to departmental management, human resource management, fiscal management, procedure development, quality control, education, professional development, environmental management, and communication. Under general supervision, provides effective pharmaceutical services fulfilling all legal requirements and ensures that these services are utilized appropriately, in accordance with established vision, mission statement, objectives, policies and procedures of the NOR-MAN RHA. In the absence of a Staff Pharmacist, all duties assigned to that position become the responsibility of the Site Manager, with direct patient care activities taking precedence over all other duties.

This position requires a successful completion of a Criminal Records and Child Abuse check.

QUALIFICATIONS

Formal Education and/or Training:

- Bachelor of Science (Pharmacy) or equivalent from a recognized university
- Licensed, or eligibility for licensure, as a pharmacist in the Province of Manitoba
- Registered by the Pharmacy Examining Board of Canada
- Minimum of one (1) year of experience in hospital pharmacy in Canada

Other Skills/Product Knowledge:

- a) Possesses leadership ability
- b) Ability to work harmoniously with physicians and all RHA staff, without compromising department standards, goals and objectives
- c) Ability to exercise good judgement
- d) Ability to effectively communicate verbally and in writing on both professional and lay levels
- e) Ability to function independently, with flexible and personal integrity
- f) Ability to accept responsibility and demonstrate initiative
- g) Ability to meet goals and deadlines
- h) Excellent analytical and problem solving skills
- i) Ability to delegate and supervise effectively
- j) Proficient in the operation of a computer
- k) Ability to prioritize workload, ensuring direct patient care activities are accomplished first
- l) Knowledge of federal and provincial statutes governing pharmacy practice
