

Under the direction of the Senior Therapist, is accountable to work within a multi-disciplinary team setting to provide therapy services to clients in hospital, personal care homes and those clients within the Primary Health Care program as required. Encompasses the completion of assessments and goal-orientated/preventative treatment programs as well as the provision of consultations, in-services, and education to clients/staff. Participates in the mentorship and supervision of students and is responsible for providing the day to day assignments and program supervision of the rehabilitation assistants.
