

As a member of the Rehabilitation Care Team, performs duties to client/resident care under the supervision of the designated Therapist in order to ensure the highest possible standard of care. The rehabilitation care team includes Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy and Speech Language Pathology. It may involve treatment of inpatients, outpatients, personal care home residents and primary health care clients. Demonstrates and understands the philosophy of rehabilitation and reinforces this philosophy in all contacts with clients/residents, staff and the public.

This position requires successful completion of a Criminal Records and Child Abuse check.

- Grade 12 education
- Graduate of a recognized Health Care Aide/Rehabilitation Aide course

Other Skills/Product Knowledge:

- a) Must be physically able to do lifts and transfers

- c) Must have demonstrated computer keyboarding skills
- d) Working knowledge of computer systems
- e) Maintains good interpersonal relationships with clients and team members
