QUALIFICATIONS

Formal Education and/or Training:

- Grade 10 education.

Other Skills/Product Knowledge:

- Experience working in the field of addictions with specific knowledge of recovery principles.
- Orientation/basic training in the principles of Co-Occurring Disorders.
- Experience facilitating film/discussion groups as directed for groups up to 20 in size.
- Ability to communicate verbally and in writing.
- Knowledge of aboriginal issues.
- Cree/English bilinguality an asset.
- Due to the nature of the position, it is a requirement that:
 - A criminal records check indicates no outstanding charges,
 - A child abuse registry check indicates no record of abuse against children, and
 - Staff not currently engaged in substance abuse and/or problem gambling. ‘Substance abuse’ is defined as possession or use of illegal drugs, abuse of alcohol, prescription drugs or other mind-altering substances.
