

Operating with a high degree of independence, under the general guidance of the Executive Director of Community and Long Term Care Services, the Speech Language Pathologist will plan, organize and implement speech and/or language remediation programs to primarily the preschool age with some limited services to the adult/geriatric populations within the designated boundaries of the Region. As well, the Speech Language Pathologist will provide consultative, public education and parent/family training services.

This position requires a successful completion of a Criminal Records and Child Abuse check.

QUALIFICATIONS

Formal Education and/or Training:

- ◆ Eligible for/or possess registration with the Manitoba Speech & Hearing Association is required.
- ◆ Masters degree in Speech Language Pathology from an accredited/recognized University
- ◆ Sound professional judgement
- ◆ Demonstrated ability to participate in a program of rehabilitation medicine involving institutional and community therapy services
- ◆ Must carry a valid driver's license and be willing to travel
- ◆ Excellent communication, interpersonal and leadership skills
- ◆ The ability to work in a team environment is essential
- ◆ Flexibility, creativity and self-direction is essential
